ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TESTING (INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ONLY)

Applicants are expected to read, write and speak English and comprehend the spoken language. Although not required for admission, for applicants whose native language is not English or who have not received a degree from a university or college where English is the primary language of instruction, it is important to demonstrate a strong capability in English. Caltech recognizes [TOEFL](#) scores from the Educational Testing Service (ETS), [Pearson PTE](#), [IELTS](#), and other services that provide a certified English-language proficiency examination such as [Duolingo](#).

Applicants may self-report scores or arrange for the results of these tests to be sent directly to Caltech. Caltech's institution code is 4034.

All international applicants admitted for graduate study who have not graduated from a university where the primary language of instruction is English will be evaluated for English proficiency prior to the start of the academic year. Students may be required to take one of the English as a Second Language courses if additional instruction is deemed necessary.
